The Excelia Foundation is launching a Call for Projects in order to promote the ideas, actions and involvement of its community in the Foundation's three philanthropic areas:

Diversity, Disability and Responsible Entrepreneurship.

1. How does it work?

- There will be two sessions each year when you can submit your project to obtain a prize (award) or grant

2. What kinds of projects?

All projects must fall into one of the Excelia Foundation's three philanthropic areas.

- **Diversity:** any project that focusses on the acceptance of differences and raises awareness on the subjects of harassment, sexual and gender-based violence and social diversity
- **Disability:** any project that fosters a culture of inclusion and raises awareness of disability within the Excelian community
- **Responsible Entrepreneurship:** any project with a strong focus on CSR

All projects must have a clear, tangible and measurable impact on the life of the school and its students, help create a sense of community, and encourage interaction between the school's different sites.

The Committee will attach particular importance to projects whose objectives are in the common interest, as well as to initiatives that have a positive impact for the students within the Excelia group, in particular projects that involve Excelia students in the development of a socially-responsible school that embraces a global outlook.

3. Who can submit a project?

- Excelia students
- Excelia Alumni's
- Excelia student associations
- Excelia personnel and teaching faculty
- Any project leader who can justify their project's impact on at least one of Excelia's sites
